Dear Parents/Carers

Rand Farm Residential and Day Visit – March 2018

We are pleased to be able to give more information about our upcoming Rand Farm residential and day visit. We are all getting very excited!

We have sent out a 'kit' list of the items that the children will need for the residential trip. Please remember that no mobile phones or games consoles will be allowed on the trip. The children can bring books, colouring materials, etc., to occupy them on the coach and during quiet time in the evening (for children staying over).

If your child is going on the day trip, they will be going to Rand Farm on Wednesday 21st March with Mrs Edwards and staff and children from Market Rasen. The cost of the trip is £10.95, could we please have payment by Tuesday 6th March to secure you child's place and this gives permission for your child to attend the day trip.

If your child is going on the residential trip, they will be going to Rand Farm on Thursday 22nd March to Friday 23rd March with Mrs Edwards, Mrs Haynes and Mr Easby (a teacher from Market Rasen), and children from Market Rasen.

Children attending both the day trip and residential will leave Nettleton at approximately 9am, however children will need to be in school at normal time. Please come to Class 2 for registration and give any monies or medication to Mrs Edwards. Children will be back at school by the end of the school day on Wednesday if they are on the day trip, and by the end of the school day on the Friday if they are on the residential trip.

Children will not require any additional food as Rand Farm will supply all of the meals and snacks. Both children going on the day trip and residential may bring a small amount of spending money if they wish to (maximum of £5.00). Please hand over any spending money in a labelled envelope to Mrs Edwards on the morning of your child's visit. Children on the residential will be issued with a medication and consent form which will need completing and returning to the school office by **Friday 2nd March**. A kit list has also been supplied on Wisepay.

Please ensure the balance is paid in full by **6th March 2018** on Wisepay.

We have arranged an information meeting for parents to attend on **Monday 5th March at 3.15pm** in school for you to come along, find out more about what the children will be doing and ask any questions that you may have.
