School Uniform

Please note specifically:

- Only polo type t-shirts should be worn; not button up formal shirts or blouses
- P.E tracksuits need to be plain black or blue with no branding
- Earrings need to be a stud only and taken out for PE lessons
- Children need to wear correct P.E uniform on their P.E days – not clothing with sport logos, etc.

Carlton Lodge Residential

Our Year 5/6 children are very excited to be going on our residential trip to Carlton Lodge in the next couple of weeks. We will be holding an information event on Tuesday 9th September at 3.30pm. The meeting will take place in school. Please come into the main building through the office to join us for the meeting.

Attendance and Lateness

Attendance remains a high priority for us – children need to be in school to receive the best education they can and increase their chances of success in later life.

Can we remind you that school starts at 8.40am. Our doors open at 8.30am and children should go into their classroom with their class at this time. We will closely monitor attendance and lateness and arrange panel meetings if they are required.

Can we also remind you that term time holidays will not be authorised. We are starting year two of the revised attendance policy and follow the Local Authority guidance regarding absences during term time.

Penalty notice information is as follows:



Penalty Notice	Details
First Notice in a 3 year period:	Issued to each parent. Charged at £80 if paid within 21 days £160 if paid within 28 days.
Second Notice in a 3 year period:	Issued to each parent. Charged at a flat rate of £160 if paid within 28 days.
Third Notice in a 3 year period:	Alternative action should be taken, for example prosecution or other attendance legal interventions. Fines per parent are capped at two within any three-year period. If a parent is prosecuted for their child's non-attendance, they could face a magistrates court appearance and a fine of up to £2,500 and/or prison. Cases found guilty in Magistrates' Court can show on a Parents future DBS certificate, due to failure to safeguard a child's education.

Additional INSET training will involve twilight training sessions.

Defeat the Sweet

We continue to follow the Local Authority Defeat the Sweet policy – this is vital in ensuring the health and well being of our children.

We remain a water / milk only school. Fizzy and other drinks are not allowed in school. If there is a medical reason your child cannot drink water and need an alternative, please make an appointment with myself to discuss further.

Snacks – Key Stage One have a healthy snack provided each day.

Key Stage Two children can bring in their own healthy snack for playtimes – no chocolate or sweets please.

Safeguarding Policy: Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility. If you have a concern about a child please speak to the school Designated Safeguarding Lead (Nichola Allerston) or contact Lincolnshire's Children's services on 01522 782111

Parent Code of Conduct: All staff and children have the right to feel safe and secure on our school site. Threatening behaviour including shouting at staff, anti-social behaviour or use of foul language will not be tolerated and could lead to a ban from site.

Behaviour Policy: This policy outlines our positive behaviour management system and outlines how we reward children and also how will work with children and parents if things go wrong.
