Y5/6 Bomber Command Centre Trip

As part of our History topic this term, we have organised a trip to the Bomber Command Centre in Lincoln. Nettleton children will attend with a class of children from Market Rasen C of E Primary School on Wednesday 3rd June. It will be a full day's trip with coach travel to and from the venue.

The purpose of our visit to the Bomber Command Centre will be to supplement and apply our classroom learning about World War Two. We will understand more about the role played by Bomber Command during the war, as well as gaining a better understanding of the history of the RAF in Lincolnshire. From the displays and interactive experiences, children will also be able to appreciate the scale of the conflict, and the sacrifice of many airmen and civilians during WW2. Having conducted a pre-visit to the venue before booking the trip, I know that children will gain a huge amount of additional learning from the planned activities and will be moved by the exhibits and histories behind them.

Children will work through the following activities as part of their visit:

- 1) 'Their Story-Our Story' workshop - WWII artefact and object handling in the suite, led by the Learning Officer.
- 2) Outside tour of spire and memorial - facilitated by a Learning Team volunteer. This will also include use of the Anderson Shelter.
- 3) Visit to inside interactive exhibition - facilitated by a Learning Team volunteer. Clipboards, pencils and trail provided.

Friend of Schools have very kindly agreed to cover the cost of the coach and entry to the venue, **there is no cost to parents**. Please click [here](#) to give consent for your child to take part in this trip by Friday 22nd May.

Children will need to wear their school uniform, but please dress appropriately for the weather (particularly hats and sunscreen if it's warm and/or rain jacket if wet).

Children will require a packed lunch for the trip. Please ensure your child brings a water bottle/s, so that they have enough to drink. If your child is FSM a packed lunch can be ordered from the school kitchen, this is included on the consent FORMS.
