## Head Teacher's Newsletter Summer Term 2019

Welcome back to the summer term. We hope you had a lovely Easter break and that your child is refreshed for the exciting term ahead. This newsletter will let you know about some important dates and events going on in school between now and the end of the year.

## Trim Trail

We hope to be able to start using the Trim Trail once again soon. We ask that your child has trainers, plimsolls or suitable shoes in school if they wish to use the trim trail.

## **National Tests Dates**

The Year One Phonics Screening will take place the week beginning 10<sup>th</sup> June 2019. The Year Two National Curriculum Tests will take place the week beginning 20<sup>st</sup> May 2019. The Year Six National curriculum tests will take place the week beginning 13<sup>th</sup> May 2019.

## Attendance in school is important all of the time but particularly important during these weeks.

## Year One Phonics Screening

The phonics screening check is a short, simple assessment to make sure that all pupils are able to decode phonics to an appropriate standard by the age of 6. All Year One pupils in maintained schools, academies and free schools must complete the check. The phonics check will help teachers identify the children who need extra help so they can receive the support they need to improve their reading skills. These children will then be able to retake the check in Year Two. The check comprises a list of 40 words and non-words which the child will read one-to-one with a teacher. If you would like any more information about the phonics screen please speak to your child's teacher

## Year Two National Curriculum Tests

Children in Year Two will undertake test in reading and maths. These tests are just one part of the teacher assessment that will be reported to you at the end of the year. As the children are so young we do everything we can to ensure the tests do not worry them in any way. If you have any questions about the Year Two tests please speak to your child's teacher.

## Year Six National Curriculum Tests

The children will undertake their National Curriculum tests soon. They will be tested in reading, grammar, spelling, arithmetic and mathematical reasoning. Your child's results will be shared with you at the end of the summer term. If you have any questions about the Year Six tests please speak to your child's teacher.







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#### Attendance

Our attendance continues to be good this year; thank you for your support with this. We will award any child (around 200 at present) with a special medal at the end of the year if their attendance is over 97%. I hope to be awarding many of these medals. If your child is not going to be at school for any reason please let us know before 9.30am of the first day of absence.

#### Sun Safety

Hopefully we will have some good weather during the summer term. May I please remind parents that if the sun is particularly hot you should provide a sunhat and sun cream in a named bottle. Staff cannot apply sun cream to children so it would be useful if this was also applied before the start of the school day.

#### **Reading Volunteers**

As I'm sure you are aware, at Nettleton Community Primary School, we place importance on regular reading practice. Reading to an adult and discussing books is an extremely important part of learning to read, both at home and at school, and we like to provide as many opportunities as possible for children to do this.

We would like to recruit some more parents, carers and grandparents volunteers to come into school and work with our children across the school, hearing them read and talking about the books. If you could spare an hour or so each week to do this, mainly in the afternoons, we would love to hear from you. You may want to volunteer in your child's class or you might be happy working across the school in different year groups. Please can you see Miss Morgan if you would like to join us to hear children read at school.

### **Sports Day**

Our annual sports day will be held on Tuesday 21st May 2019 at 9.15am on the playing field. If the weather is bad that day our reserve day is Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> June 2019. We hope you can join us for this event.
