Expression of Interest for Year 5 and 6 Residential 2020 (for Current Y4/5 Pupils)

As you might know we have changed our residential trip to a two year cycle to give children more opportunities as they move through school.

We are proposing to take the children for a 2 night, 3 day residential to London in October 2020. This will be an amazing opportunity for the children to learn about history, geography and British values. Each year we take the children to London for a day trip and this residential will replace that trip and give the children more time to experience the sights and sounds of London.

We expect the cost to be similar to the Carlton Lodge visit which usually is between £130 and £160. This will include coach, travel and meals.

All Year 5 and 6 children at both Market Rasen and Nettleton will be invited to attend. Nettleton and one Market Rasen class would go Monday - Wednesday and two Market Rasen classes will go Wednesday to Friday. The children would stay at the YHA, St Pauls Cathedral. We expect to have the whole floor of the accommodation to ourselves. <u>Please follow this link to find out more about YHA St Pauls.</u> As ever, we will have good adult to child ratios to ensure children are safe.

We have not finalised the itinerary yet however there are many amazing sites within walking distance from the accommodation including:

- St Paul's Cathedral
- · River Thames and Riverboat to Greenwich
- · London Eye / Houses of Parliament
- · Tate Modern
- Museum of London
- Tower of London

At this stage we would like an expression of interest. Please complete and return the slip overleaf if your child is

likely to attend so we can book transport and accommodation. Please return to the school office by Friday 11th October 2019.

If you have any questions about this visit please let me know. We will hold a parents meeting after we have looked at numbers so we can go through all aspects of the visit in detail so parents can make an informed choice whether or not they would like their child to attend.
