

## **School Crossing Patrols**

Where there is a school crossing patrol site close to your school, we request that you encourage parents to use it. The patrols are in place to make school journeys safer for all.

#### **Congestion around schools**

In an effort to achieve social distancing within schools, some areas have instead seen congestion in public spaces outside schools.

We advise against allowing large groups of people to gather in car parks, on roads or driveways where there may be moving vehicles.
