Dear Parents/Carers

As I communicated last night it was with great sadness that we have closed our schools to most children again.

Apologies in advance for the length of this letter however I want to ensure our whole school community is aware of how we intend to operate over the next few weeks.

Information for Vulnerable and Children of Critical Workers

Firstly thank you for so quickly responding to our FORM yesterday. This really helped with our planning.

Critical Worker and Vulnerable Provision Take up

The number of children who have applied for critical worker or vulnerable provision has far exceeded our expectations. Whilst we have the capacity for the number who have applied, I should stress that the aim of the national lockdown is to reduce contacts and this is less effective with the number of children we have in.

To help us with this I would ask you to:

- Let us know if, on reflection, you do not need the space because there is someone at home to look after your child. If this is the case please e-mail Katie.Taylor-Bailey@marketrasen.lincs.sch.uk
- In the case of children of keyworkers, only send your child in on the days the provision is needed. For example, if you have a day off keep your child home with you and access the remote learning offer.

If you really do need this important provision please know that we are happy to provide it.

Information For Children Who Are Not Able To Attend School

Remote Learning Plan

We have a robust remote learning plan that will begin tomorrow (Wednesday 6th January 2021). There is an expectation from the Government that children will do at least three hours of remote learning a day. Our view is that we will provide this much and you should try to do as much of it as possible given your individual circumstances.

The learning we set will be a mixture of videos, PDFs and PowerPoints. Children from Years 1-6 will give their answers via FORMS. This will allow teachers to assess their learning and give advice and feedback. For our Reception children there will be a short FORM for parents to complete each day to tell us how your child is getting on.

The video lessons will be recorded by someone in the federation team; it may not always be your child's class teacher that is teaching the lesson.

We will contact families where children don't appear to be accessing the learning to see how we can support you.

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How To Access The Lessons

All of the lessons will be on our school website on the Online Learning Tab. The links can be found below. The work will be ready by 9.30 daily at the latest.

We will send a Wisepay Reminder each day with the above links embedded.

When you click on the links the work should just load. If you are watching a TEAMS video you will need to choose the option "watch on the web" to make it play unless you have a TEAMS account that you can use.

The work will only be up for the day it is set so it is important that your child attempts to complete the work on the day it is uploaded. We ask for the work to be submitted by 2.00 p.m. daily to enable the teachers to mark and assess it.

Safeguarding

Please ensure your child is supervised when using the internet to access the work we have set.

What if my child is struggling with the work?

We have staff on hand that will be able to talk you or your child through anything they are struggling with. Please call or e-mail the office to request a call back. The call back will be from someone in that year group team across the Federation. The call may come from a phone with a withheld ID so please answer if you can.

What If I don't have a device?

We know from our research that not all families have enough devices to complete the online learning. We have allocated some devices we bought to those families in the most need. We are awaiting a delivery of laptops from the Department of Education which should be enough for all families who stated they needed it. We will be in touch with those families once they arrive.

Sometimes these calls will come from a withheld ID so please answer if you can.

Data for Devices

We have a number of free Vodafone 30GB data sims for use in cellular devices if your child needs them for home learning. Please e-mail the main office should you require one of these.
