Handwriting Task

We have been delighted with the English work that the children have produced as part of their online English learning. However, we are conscious that the children would usually write in class and their teacher would be able to praise them for their efforts and offer feedback to make their writing even better. With this in mind, we would like you to email this week's writing task directly to their teacher on Friday.

We do not expect the writing to be a 'display' piece. We know that, as part of the writing process, there will be grammatical errors and spelling mistakes. In school, we encourage the children to make exciting vocabulary choices and attempt the spelling of new words. Please send a photograph of their work as we would like the work to be handwritten. We are conscious that the children are spending time using screens and want to develop and maintain their handwriting.

Your child's teacher will be delighted to see their work and will provide individual feedback by email directly to you by the end of next week. The children can then respond to the feedback in their next piece of longer writing, which will be in two weeks' time. Please ensure that the work is sent from your email address as we cannot send feedback to a child's own email address.

Those children in school will complete their work in class so do not need to duplicate their writing. However, if your child is in school for some of the time, their teacher will provide the materials so that they can continue with their writing task at home.

Thank you for your continued support and we hope that this personalised feedback will enable the children to work on their individual targets.
