Live Drop In TEAMS Sessions For Children Accessing Remote Learning

The outcomes of our remote learning questionnaire were extremely positive however, as a Federation that always wants to improve, we have made some changes based on what you said including:

- Improving the accuracy of the points scoring system.
- Adding a marking and feedback section in the videos so the children get instant feedback.
- Introduced daily maths feedback to support understanding of the White Rose videos.
- Introducing a regular writing activity that enables children to get specific feedback via e-mail.

I hope that this has further improved your child's remote learning experience.

Something new, that we are hoping to start next week, are some optional live drop in sessions.

These will not be lessons but a chance for children to see their classmates and teacher in an informal setting. We think it will be good for well-being, maintaining relationships and getting children ready for their return to school. If you would like your child to take part you will need to give consent. If you have more than one child you will need to do a form for each child.
