### Cost of Living Crisis

We appreciate that inflation and energy prices are making things tough for many of our families. If you are struggling, please get in touch as we may be able to provide you with some direct support for things that are school related or signpost you to organisations we work closely with if not school related.

We would encourage all EYFS and KS1 children to access the free school meals from our five-star rated kitchen and LCC Gold rated menus. It is estimated that taking these meals will save families £400 per year per child. For children in KS2 please remember that we offer hot meals (jacket potato, topping, fruit or yoghurt) for just £1.00.

Please note that from Year 3, fruit is no longer provided as a break time snack for the children. If your child would like a break time snack we would appreciate if you could send a piece of fruit in with them each day.

### Communication with School

We are very lucky to have our own on-site swimming pool as water safety and learning to swim are essential life skills. The governor agreed contribution for swimming is £2.00 per session.

You will understand that the running costs of the pool and travelling costs are very expensive, especially in the current climate of rising gas, electric and fuel prices, and it is only through your contributions that we will be able to continue to offer swimming lessons. To pay, please log on to your child's Wisepay account and click on the swimming link (this will be set up week commencing Monday 9<sup>th</sup> September). Alternatively, you can pay in cash at the school office if preferred. **The cost for the full 6-week term is £12.00.**
