Granny Cooper’s Yummy Yummy

Ingredients:

4 tbsp’s Golden Syrup

6 oz Margarine

1.5 lb Digestive Biscuits

2 tbsp’s Caster Sugar

4 tbsp’s Coco Powder

1 bar of decorating chocolate

Method:

1. Grease and line a baking tray
2. Crush up the biscuits (either pulsing in a blender or by putting in a bag and crushing with a rolling pin)
3. Melt the golden syrup, margarine and sugar in a pan being careful not to burn them.
4. Take off the heat and add the coco powder, combine well
5. Stir in the crushed biscuit and combine well
6. Pour the mixture into a greased and lined baking tray, pop in the fridge to set
7. Melt the decorating chocolate and pour over the harden biscuit mixture, return to the fridge to set
