We are delighted to have been able to plan a residential trip, for all Year 3 & Year 4 children, to Sherwood Forest in March/April 2025, which will consist of two days with an overnight stay.

The residential visits will take place between **Monday 31st March and Friday 4th April**. The children will be going in their class for two of the days during this week. Details of the exact days will be sent to you nearer the time.

The children will leave for Sherwood Forest at the beginning of the school day and return by home time of the next day. Whilst on the residential, they will be involved in a variety of fun and educational activities linked to our topics which we know they will enjoy. The children will develop a range of skills including creating wild art and shelter building as well as developing the life skills that come with staying away from home. The cost for the residential trip is approximately £95.00, which will include transport, meals, accommodation and all the activities.
