As you are aware, the Key Stage Two assessments will be held for children in Year 6 from Monday 12th May to Thursday 15th May. They will take the assessments as follows:

| Monday 12 May | English grammar, punctuation and spelling Paper 1: grammar questions |
| Monday 12 May | English grammar, punctuation and spelling Paper 2: spelling |
| Tuesday 13 May | English reading |
| Wednesday 14 May | Mathematics Paper 1: arithmetic |
| Wednesday 14 May | Mathematics Paper 2: reasoning |
| Thursday 15 May | Mathematics Paper 3: reasoning |

Separately, your child's teacher will make a teacher-assessed judgement in Writing and Science.
